

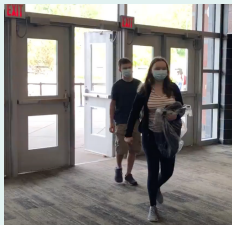


LAKE ORION HIGH SCHOOL PROCEDURES 2020-21

Lake Orion High School students will follow these procedures for in-person attendance during the 2020-21 school year.

Start of the day in the building

- No students will be allowed to enter the building without properly wearing a mask.
- Students riding the bus will show the Clear To Go app clearance to the bus driver.
- All students will have the Clear To Go app checked for the clearance prior to entering the building.
- Students will go directly to first period. No congregating in hallways or the Commons.



Passing time between classes

- Students are required to wear a mask during passing time.
- Students are expected to maintain a minimum of 6 feet from other peers during passing time.
- Students will wash or sanitize hands when leaving and entering a class.

Hallway and Stairwell traffic

- Students will walk on the right side of the hallways and stairs throughout the building.
- Students are expected to maintain a minimum of 6 feet from others in the hallways.

Late students

- Students arriving to school late will be required to check-in at the main entrance attendance desk.
- Students will show the Clear To Go app to the attendance staff member.
- Students will receive a time-stamped pass and will go directly to their class period.
- The student will show the time-stamped pass to the teacher to enter the classroom.



Restroom usage

- Restrooms will have posted maximum capacities. Some toilets/sinks may be offline to promote social distancing.
- Students may use the restroom on an as-needed basis.



During class

- All students must be properly wearing a mask during class.
- Desks and students will be separated as far apart as physically possible.
- Students will be assigned a seat in each class.



Masks



- All students will be required to wear a mask (covering nose, mouth, and chin) AT ALL TIMES inside of the school building. Face shields, gaiters and bandanas are not acceptable substitutes.
- Masks must be made of cloth (or 3-ply disposable) and able to cover the student's nose, mouth, and chin, fitting snugly over the ears without handheld assistance.
- Masks must comply with the student dress code in regard to slogans and designs.
- Masks must be washed after one-time use. Students should plan on having a minimum of 5 masks (one for each day of the week). It is highly recommended that students have extra.

End of the day -- Dismissal

- Building will use multiple assigned exits and staggered dismissals.

Reminders

- The "drinking" part of the drinking fountain will not be used. Students should bring a water bottle to fill at the water stations.
- Students should carry individual backpacks because lockers will not be used.
